Joos joined Consumers Energy in 1976 and has spent his entire career with the company with the exception of the period 1979 to 1983, when he worked as a design engineer for a major architect-engineering firm. During his CMS career, he has held senior level positions in operations, engineering, marketing and regulatory affairs. Prior to his current position, Joos was president and chief operating officer of CMS Energy and Consumers Energy from 2001-2004.

He is a board member and past chairman of the Michigan Manufacturing Association, and a board member of the Edison Electric Institute. He is a member of the board of directors of Steelcase Inc. and the Detroit Renaissance, Inc. board.

He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in engineering science in 1975 and a Master of Science degree in nuclear engineering in 1976, both from Iowa State University. In 1989, he completed the Program for Management Development at the Harvard Business School. He is a licensed professional engineer in Michigan.
