Jon R. Robinson is vice president and deputy general counsel — utility law and regulation for Consumers Energy, with responsibility for all legal issues related to public utility law and regulation before the Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC), the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and the appellate courts. He was elected to the post in 2004.

Robinson was previously assistant general counsel and was responsible for supervising legal work before the MPSC and FERC. He joined Consumers Energy in 1977, and left for private practice in 1983. He returned to the company in 1990.
